The contract will start in spring 2017. It will be limited to 3 years with the possibility of extension. The Department for Economic Policy and Institutional Economics, University of Freiburg, cooperates with the Walter Eucken Institute. The position may involve partial employment at both institutions.

The successful candidate will perform research in microeconomics, with a focus on applied/behavioral economics. He/She will write a PhD thesis on a self-determined topic. It is possible to participate in the PhD courses of the Universities of Strassbourg, Basel, KIT Karlsruhe, Colmar and Mulhouse. Extensive contacts within our national and international research network offer the opportunity to get involved in the international research community at an early stage of the career. While the focus will be on research, the successful candidate will also be involved in teaching and conference organization.

Applicants require an excellent degree in economics, a sound knowledge of quantitative and experimental methods, and are interested in microeconomics. We welcome applications from graduates with a diploma/master's degree in economics. Fluency in English is required; command of German is appreciated.

Salary is based on the TV-L 13 statutory salary scale. We support equal opportunities and encourage women to apply.
